Czechoslovak Discussion Conference

The first Czechoslovak Discussion Conference on "Models of Bipolymer Structure and Functions" will be held in Mariánské Lázně spa near Carlsbad (160 km distance from Prague) from September 14 to 19, 1970; it will be sponsored by the International Union of Pure and Applied Chemistry and the International Union of Pure and Applied Biophysics.

The following topics are tentatively scheduled:

- (a) catalytic active centers on biopolymers and their models;
- (b) structure and properties of biological membranes and their models;
- (c) transfer of energy on chain macromolecules;
- (d) (ionic) interactions in macromolecular systems;
- (e) structure and properties of aqueous macromolecular systems;
- (f) the macromolecule as a cooperative system;
- (g) storage and propagation of information in macromolecular systems;
- (h) mechanochemistry of macromolecules.
