

ANNOUNCEMENTS

The Commission on Cell and Membrane Biophysics of the International Union for Pure and Applied Biophysics is proposing to hold a Symposium on Permeability Problems at Jerusalem, Israel, from 2nd to 9th July 1968. The topics to be discussed will be:

1. Transport Problems in Animals and Plants Exposed to Arid Conditions
2. Transport across Epithelia
3. Water Transport in Biological Systems
4. Physical Chemistry of Charged Membranes
5. The Theoretical Interpretation of Tracer Fluxes

For each topic, the Commission will invite two speakers to give introductory talks, and will select eight others from names submitted by the National Committees for Biophysics. The selection will be made strictly on the grounds of relevance of the proposed contribution to the particular session.
