Biophysical Society 1969 National Meeting

Simultaneous with the imposition of severe restrictions on the funding of foreign travel, the Department of Health, Education and Welfare has ruled that Canada is "foreign," and has indicated that these restrictions will hold at least through Inauguration Day. Rather than risk crippling the attendance of members who derive their travel funds from U.S.P.H.S. grants, the Executive Board voted to relocate the 1969 National Meeting (which was to be in Toronto) within the United States. At its May meeting, the Board passed a resolution that Toronto be re-inserted into the sequence of meeting sites as soon as possible.

The 1969 National Meeting will now be held at Los Angeles, California, February 26-28, in the Statler-Hilton Hotel. The new Local Arrangements Committee consists of Drs. V. Schumaker (Chairman), A. Brady, and E. H. Strickland. It is anticipated that some activities will occur on the evening of the 25th, and that certain satellite meetings of interest to biophysicists will occur on the 1st.

American Institute of Ultrasonics in Medicine

The American Institute of Ultrasonics in Medicine will hold its annual meeting on November 4-7, 1968 in New Orleans, Louisiana in the Monteleone Hotel. The first day of the meeting will be devoted to tutorial papers on the basic principles of diagnostic ultrasound and a workshop session on applications in echoencephalography, cardiology, ophthalmology, obstetrics, gynecology, abdominal investigations, and Doppler studies. The last day will be devoted to terminology on diagnostic ultrasound to be adopted by the AIUM and on methods to measure the performance of the equipment.

Scientific papers are invited on clinical applications and developments in technique and instrumentation. A two-quarter page abstract including figures should be sent by the 15th of September to G. Kossoff, Biophysical Research Laboratory, University of Illinois, Urbana, Illinois. These will be published as proceedings of the meeting. The registration fee is \$25.00.
